David Leyonhjelm is a vet, with a law degree and an MBA. He has worked as a columnist for agricultural magazines and for the national financial press. Originally from Heywood, Victoria, now residing in Sydney, Senator Leyonhjelm has boxed the compass politically in trying to find a home for his strong views on personal liberty and limited government. Starting with Young Labor and a stand against the draft, then working for the Liberal interest until the Howard Government's changed policy on Gun ownership, then working with Shooters Party until he found them too narrow in focus. The senator ran the national campaigns for the Liberal Democratic Party in 2007, 2010 & 2013 - and was successful in gaining a six year term starting 1st July this year for NSW.
